- Ensure the availability of the necessary information and resources to achieve the set objectives and targets on efficient driving.
- To reduce the environmental impacts of the activity, reducing fuel consumption and greenhouse gas emissions, as well as noise pollution.
- To inform, train and raise awareness of the staff involved in order to contribute to the improvement of efficient driving performance.
